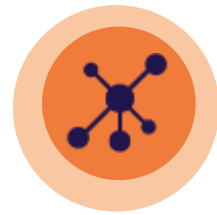
Industrial Landscape – Haryana



Industrial Leadership

- ❑ USD 26.64 Bn Industry output (Industry sector GSVA), ~30% of total GSVA*.
- ❑ 2nd largest exporter in India (Landlocked), total exports of USD 23.60 Bn*
- ❑ Major exporting products include – basmati rice, readymade garments, auto parts, carpets, electric machinery, etc
- ❑ 3rd largest software exporting State of India
- ❑ One of the biggest producers of food grains in India. More than 60% export of Basmati Rice from India is from Haryana
- ❑ Haryana manufactures 80% of excavators, 52% of cranes, 50% of cars and 33% of two wheelers in India

State of the Art Infrastructure

- ❑ **Connectivity**
 - 27,235 km Road Network, 1703 km Rail Network and 5 civil airports
 - Dedicated 135 km Kundali Manesar Palwal (KMP) State Industrial Corridor
 - Major industrial corridors of DMIC & AKIC passing through Haryana
- ❑ **Logistics and Warehousing**
 - 12 Inland Container Depots (ICDs), 3 Container Freight Stations & 8 Private Freight Terminals
 - Integrated multi modal logistic hub in Narnaul spread over 886 acres
 - 1 Mn TEU warehousing capacity including 250 cold storage
- ❑ **Industrial Area**
 - Sector specific Industrial Zones - Food Parks, Footwear Parks, IT Parks, Electronic Cluster etc.
 - Plug and Play infrastructure across State

Policies

- ❑ Industrial Policy (HEEP 2020) to promote Entrepreneurship, Export & Employment
 - Investment subsidy (up to 150% of FCI), Employment Generation Subsidy up to USD 640/employee/yr.), upto 100% reimbursement on Stamp duty and Electricity duty, Interest Subsidy (upto 7% on term loan) etc.
- ❑ Sectoral Policies to address niche requirement of emerging sectors; Agro & Food Processing, IT & ESDM, Pharmaceuticals etc.

Ease of Doing Business

- ❑ Institutionalized 301 industrial reforms across 25 State Departments in 2020-21
- ❑ Reduced burden of 500+ compliances for industries in 2020-21
- ❑ One Roof, One Portal, One Relationship Manager for all industries
- ❑ 22 offices across the State to address local issues
- ❑ Grievance Redressal Portal to centrally resolve industrial issues

Single Window

- ❑ One Portal (www.investharyana.com) to provide 150+ industrial approvals across 25+ departments
 - Online application
 - Online Payment
 - Online Tracking
 - Digital Certificates
 - Deemed approval after 45 days
- ❑ 300,000 services processed through HEPC's single window portal in last 3 Years
- ❑ Average approval time – 22 days

Export Excellence

- ❑ 152% Merchandise export growth in last 6 Years
- ❑ 2nd largest exporting State in India (Landlocked)
- ❑ 3rd in Export Preparedness Index 2020 (landlocked)
- ❑ State with highest number of large OEMs. 33% large OEMs in India are from Haryana
- ❑ Export Promotion Industrial Park in Sonipat on 108 Acres (housing 252 units)
- ❑ State & District Level Trade Promotion Committees to address trade related issues

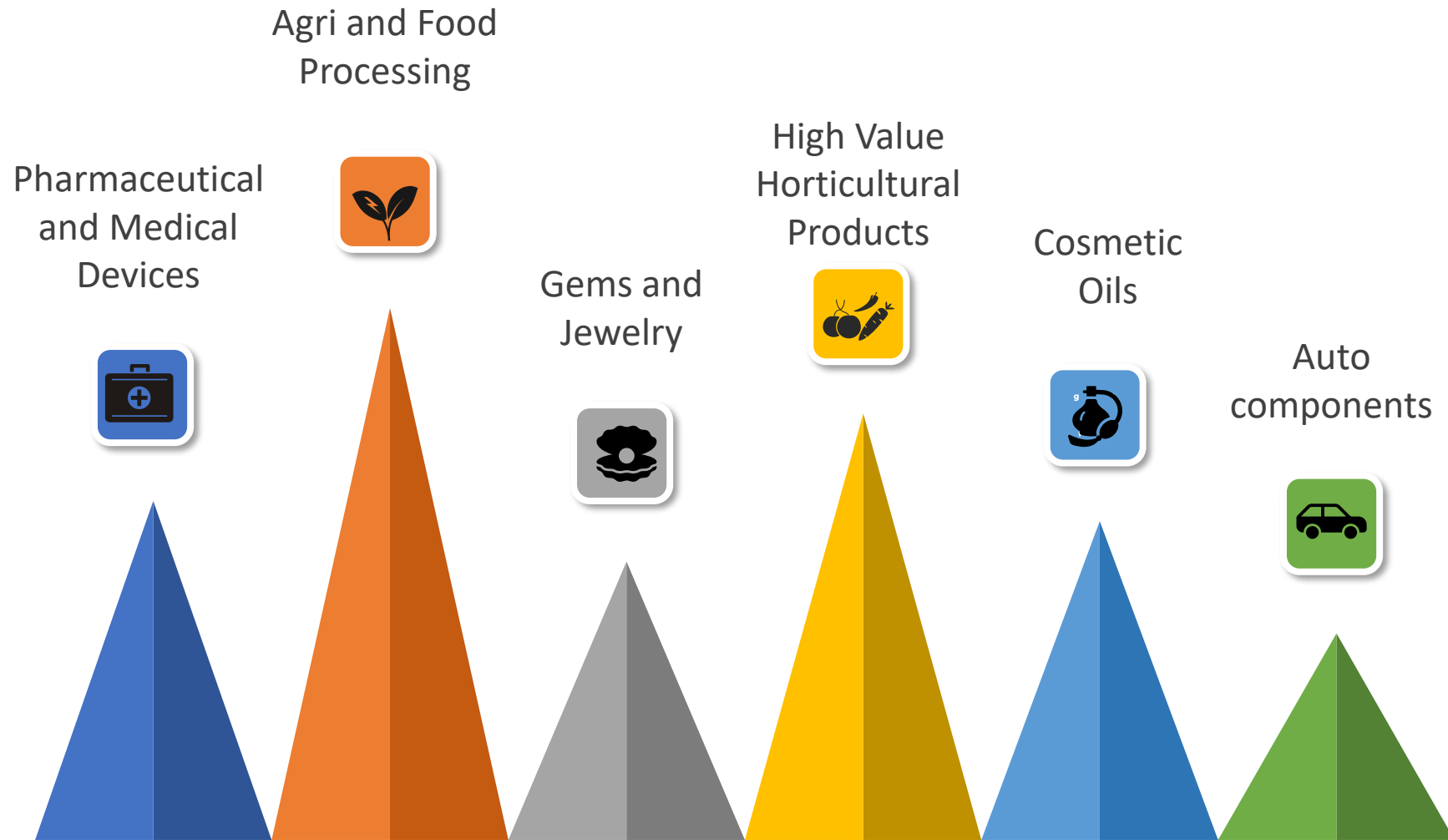
