AIFF HAILS PM NARENDRA MODI'S ANNOUNCEMENT TO BUILD 'MODERN FOOTBALL STADIUM' IN LADAKH

The All India Football Federation (AIFF) on Sunday hailed Prime Minister Narendra Modi's announcement to build a "modern football stadium" in Ladakh, saying that the initiative will help in the development of local talent in the Union Territory.

During his Mann Ki Baat radio broadcast on Sunday, PM Modi said that Ladakh will soon be blessed with an impressive Open Synthetic Track and Astro Turf Football Stadium.

"This modern football stadium in Ladakh will also have a synthetic track with eight lanes. Apart from this, there will also be a hostel facility with one thousand beds. You will also like to know that this stadium has also been certified by FIFA," the PM said.

INDIA CELEBRATES ITS 73rd REPUBLIC DAY CELEBRATIONS AT RAJPATH NEW DELHI

The Covid-19 vaccination drive started on Jan 16, 2021. Vaccination for the age group of 15-18 years began on Jan 3 this year, and booster doses began from January 10 2022.

Manohar Lal said that IGNOU with its 67 regional centers is working to provide higher education to the students. IGNOU is playing an important role in providing education to remote villages, he added.

IGNOU Regional Centre, Karnal was started in the year 1991 with only 9 study centers having 3200 students and today more than 99,000 students are taking education in 35 study centers including 12 study centers located in jails.

He said that the National Education Policy formulated under the leadership of Prime Minister, Sh. Narendra Modi has the potential to take the ordinary students of the village and the city to achieve topmost positions in the world.

The National Education Policy is being appreciated across the country. It is capable to increase its base in global competition through its knowledge, scientific research, social science technology, and innovation, he added.

CM HARYANA: IMPLEMENT AMBITIONS SCHEMES IN HARYANA

Haryana CM said that the government has implemented ambitious schemes like Parivar Pehchan Patra to live up to the expectations of the people so that the eligible persons can get the benefits of the government schemes directly.

He interacted with the volunteers connected under the Samarpan Portal, He said that so far 1,485 people of the state have registered to work voluntarily on the portal. As many as 1,312 men and 173 women have come forward to work voluntarily and mostly comprising of youth. He said that 2.73 crore people from about 67 lakh families of the state have declared their data through PPP.

CM HARYANA: CONSTRUCTION OF ADI BADRI DAM AT SARASWATI RIVER

Haryana CM said that constant work is being done towards promoting solar energy in the state as a result of which Haryana is moving at a fast pace in the field of solar energy for the last five years.

"Seven years ago not much work was done in this area. Till the year 2014, only 492 solar pumps were installed. The present government has given about 25,000 solar pump connections and the work of providing 13,800 connections is in progress. The state government has set a target of installing 50,000 solar pump sets, He said that the farmers have to spend only 25 percent on these pumps and up to 75 percent subsidy is given by the government..

"These connections are also being given only to those who are adopting a micro-irrigation system," added the CM.
