
HARYANA CM MEETS GERMAN DELEGATION


## HARYANA HONOURS DOCTORS AGED ABOVE 75 WITH 'VAT VRIKSHA' AWARD

Manohar Lal said that under the Parivar Pehchan Patra scheme the government was aiming at fostering entrepreneurial spirit among 150 thousand families having an income of less than Rs. 100 thousand, since giving jobs to everybody is not possible, we want to make them self-employed and these melas would assess their potential and banks would make loans available," Sh. Manohar Lal said. In the first phase, a survey through these melas would be carried out from November 29 to December 25 and youth across the state would be given a chance to choose their profession at 180 places. He said the Mukhyamantri Antyodaya Utthan Yojana had been implemented to raise people's standard of living and Antyodaya Gram Utthan Melas are being organised under this scheme.

Sh. Manohar Lal inaugurated the modern digitized revenue record rooms in all the 22 districts of the state. 185 million records have been scanned and digitized in all districts of Haryana; these records will be made easily available. Modern revenue record rooms will prove to be an important initiative for the government to eliminate corruption and bring more transparency in the system, said Sh. Manohar Lal after launching the system. The first Modern Revenue in the state was set up on June 24, 2017 and after that on December 25, 2019, on the occasion of Good Governance Day. These record rooms have been prepared in all the districts ahead of time.
