- Leading Indian companies in Nigeria are Bharti Airtel, Tata, Bajaj Auto, Birla Group, Kirloskar, Mahindra, Ashok Leyland, NIIT, New India Assurance, Bhushan Steel, KEC, Dabur, Godrej and Primus Super-speciality Hospital. Nigeria's pharmaceuticals, steel and power transmission sectors are dominated by Indian companies.
